

Camp close to the action!

Experience the High Desert Stampede by staying close to the action. The High Desert Stampede is offering camp sites for RV dry camping right on the property of the Deschutes County Fair and Expo. Bring your RV and camp with your friends and take the opportunity to make new friends.

General Camping Info

- Camping passes will be sold on a per site basis and are valid from 12pm (Noon) Wednesday, April 3 through 12pm (Noon) on Sunday, April 7th.
- Pass price includes one vehicle. Extra vehicles must be parked in the main fairgrounds parking area.
- RV camp spaces are designed to accommodate six people.
- All RV's must be parked front to back in the provided spot. (No horseshoeing, boxing, etc.)
- "RV camping" is considered anything with wheels (fifth-wheels, motorhomes, camper-vans, travel-trailers, truck campers and tent trailers.) There is NO tent camping.
- All RV sites are on the fairgrounds and are within easy walking distance to the arena.
- Camp hosts will be available at the site to assist campers in finding their assigned spot and to answer rodeo related questions. The camp host space will be designated with a lawn sign for easy identification.

RV Camping Regulations

- Amenities: there are no hookups available at the RV camp site.
- **Check-In Time:** begins Wednesday after 12:00 pm. Please do not arrive before 12:00 pm. Once your RV has been parked in your assigned spot, you will not be allowed to move it.
- **Check-Out time:** no later than 12:00 pm on Sunday after the rodeo. Please leave your site cleaner than when you found it.

RV Camping Regulations (continued)

- Fires: Absolutely NO FIREWORKS, CAMP FIRES, OPEN FLAMES OR OPEN FLAME CANDLES will be allowed. This includes pellet grills, charcoal grills and other open flame devices. Propane stoves, fire pits, grills and barbecues, with shut off valves, will be allowed. Propane grills must be 30 inches above the ground at all time whether they are free standing or on a tabletop. Traegers are not allowed. Patrons who behave in a way that could be considered obscene, indecent, lewd, racially offensive, suggestive, harassing, threatening, objectionable, or unlawful shall be subject to removal from the camping area and the Fairgrounds.
- **Protect Your Belongings** and lockup all valuables including coolers and generators when leaving them unattended and overnight. The High Desert Stampede and Deschutes County Fair and Expo are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property of any kind.
- Quiet Time: Please be considerate of your neighbors and observe the established quiet times, 10:00 PM until 7:00 AM. (RV Park next door has 10:00 pm quite time) Whisper quiet type generators may be allowed overnight if they do not disturb or asphyxiate other campers. Courtesy goes a long way.
- **Pets:** Must be on leash at all times. Please Clean up after your pet.
- Trash: Trash bins will be provided available in the camping area
- Porta-potties: Two Porta Potties will be available in the camping area
- **RV Dump Station**: Located adjacent to the airport for a fee

Rules Schmools! What if I don't want to follow them?

• It is very simple: If you do not follow the rules you will be asked to leave. If you do not leave it will be considered trespassing. If you are trespassing one of Redmond or Deschutes county's finest and friendly officers will be available to escort you off the property.
